

# PROTECTED BORDERS PLAN

INFORMATION FOR FOREIGNERS NON-RESIDING IN CHILE (TOURISTS)

VALID FROM DECEMBER 30, 2021

## I. Who can enter in Chile?

A. All foreigners not resident in Chile (tourists) who have Chilean Mobility Pass, which is the vaccination certificate against coronavirus. Vaccines received abroad must have been previously validated in Chile to obtain it.

B. Foreigners not resident in Chile (tourists) under 6 years of age who do not have been able to access vaccination against coronavirus, without the need of Chilean Mobility Pass.

C. Foreigners not resident in Chile who meet any of the exceptions contained in Decree 295 of the Ministry of the Interior.

## II. Who may NOT enter in Chile?

A. The entry of non-resident individuals who have been the last 14 days in at least one of the following countries in Africa, regardless of the vaccination status: South Africa; Zimbabwe; Namibia; Botswana; Lesotho; Eswatini; Mozambique.

B. It is prohibited the entry of any foreigner without regular residence older than 6 years of age unvaccinated or who does not have their vaccination validated previously by the Ministry of Health of Chile, and that does not comply with none of the exceptions contained in Decree 295 of the Ministry of Interior.

## III. Requirements before traveling to Chile.

A. Validation of Covid vaccines: Vaccines against Covid-19 are mandatory, which must be validated before entering the country. Vaccine validation does not expire and is a free procedure. Therefore, even if you are not sure of the date of the trip, it is advisable to do it in advance.

### 1. Steps to validate Covid vaccines

Step 1: Go to [mevacuno.gob.cl](http://mevacuno.gob.cl)

Step 2: Go to the "Email" section

Step 3: Click "Create an account". It must be done with the e-mail address of each person who is going to travel.

Step 4: Once the account is created, in the main menu go to "Validation".

Step 5: In the "Validation" section, you must fill out a form with personal information and attach documents that support each vaccination process. This information will be validated case by case by officials of the Ministry of Health, who will give an answer to the requester.

### 2. Results of the request

When validation of Covid vaccines is requested to enter Chile, there are three possible answers:

a. Incomplete: The request is rejected for being incomplete or inconsistent. The user will be able to complete their request for a new attempt.

b. Valid: The request is accepted, and the applicant's data is added to the [mevacuno.gob.cl](http://mevacuno.gob.cl) registry, leaving proof of vaccination available indefinitely, and with this the QR with the mobility pass.

c. Temporarily valid: if the individual is abroad and presents a consistent background, but not electronically verifiable. However, upon entering you may be asked for additional background information.

If the homologation has not arrived, you can write your case to the email [ayudaregistrovacunas@minsa.cl](mailto:ayudaregistrovacunas@minsa.cl). The traveler will be informed of the deadline for homologation of vaccines at the time of making the request, a process that can take up to 30 calendar days.

### 3. Vaccines that may be validated

The Covid vaccines that are approved for validation in Chile are all those that have been approved by the Chilean Institute of Public Health (ISP), the World Health Organization (WHO), the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the European Medicines Agency (EMA).

These are the vaccines that can be validated: Moderna; Pfizer/BioNTech; Janssen (Johnson&Johnson); Oxford/AstraZeneca; Synopharm; Sinovac; CanSino; Generium (Sputnik-V).

B. Negative result of the PCR test, whose sample collection cannot be older than 72 hours. These are counted up to departure time of the flight with final destination Chile if it enters via airline. If the individual has a persistent positive result for having been infected with the virus in the last month, may attach two positive PCR results, where the sampling of one must have been made up to 72 hours before shipment and the another must have been made more than 14 days apart from the date of shipment, but with less than a month from it.

C. Sworn statement for travelers from abroad, Available at [www.c19.cl](http://www.c19.cl). Every traveler, of all ages, must complete the form "Sworn Declaration of Travelers" online up to 48 hours before boarding. In this form must attach the result of the negative PCR and medical insurance of trip.

D. Travel medical insurance: This requirement is only for foreigners not residents in the country. The traveler must attach to the sworn statement of Travelers a certificate of medical insurance that covers the expenses that could cause medical assistance, hospital care and repatriation, during their entire stay in the country, including coverage of any expense caused by Covid-19. The minimum amount of Coverage for health benefits must be USD\$30,000.

*These documents will be required by the operator of the means of transportation when boarding it, and by the health authority when entering the country.*



## IV. Sanitary measures when entering Chile

A. Those who have at least the primary vaccination schedule completed and validated by the Chilean Ministry of Health: upon entering the country, a coronavirus detection test (PCR or antigens) will be carried out. Until you receive the negative result of this test, which results may be ready within the next 6 – 24 hours from the sample test, must quarantine at an address reported in the C19 form.

B. Those who are not vaccinated or do not have a complete vaccination schedule validated by the Chilean Ministry of Health: At the point of entry into the country, a coronavirus detection test (PCR) will be performed. In addition, they must carry out 168 hours (7 days) of quarantine, counted from the health control at the point of entry into the country. A negative result of the coronavirus detection test carried out at the point of entry into the country does NOT allow the quarantine period to end in advance.
